

ORDINANCE NO 9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, SECTION 151 OF ARTICLE 8 AND SECTION 400 OF ARTICLE 18 IN ORDINANCE NO. 6.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Idyllwild County Water District, Riverside County, California, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 151 of Article 8 in Ordinance No. 6 is hereby amended to read;

Amended Ord # 33 June 1975
Supply to Seperate Premises Not more than one premises shall be serviced from each service connection. Where it is necessary or deemed advisable for a customer to receive service for more than one premises through one meter, then application for such service may be granted by the Board.

Section 2. That Section 400 of Article 18 in Ordinance No. 6 is hereby amended to read;

Rate Schedule The following schedule of rates, minimum charges and special conditions pertaining thereto are established as follows:

(1) GENERAL METERED SERVICE

Rates

Next 5000 cu.ft. per 100 cubic feet
Next 6000 cu.ft. per 100 cubic feet

(a) Accumulative Minimum Service is accumulative over a 12 month period beginning with the April meter reading of each year and is payable on May 1st of each year. Service commenced before April meter reading date of each year will have the annual minimum prorated for the remaining months in the service year.

(b) The Annual Minimum Charge will entitle the consumer to the quantity of Water which that annual minimum charge will purchase at the annual quantity rates.

(c) Meters will be read three times each year and charges, for overrun above the minimum charges, will be billed on May 1, September 1 and January 1.

Special Conditions;

Multiple Premises Use; Where it is necessary or deemed advisable for a consumer to receive service for more than one premises through one meter, the Board of Directors may approve an application for such service, provided the annual minimum and the first and second blocks of the rate schedule is multiplied by the number of premises being served. The total annual minimum to be figured on the basis as if the District was serving each premises seperately.

For Construction Use

Minimum per Water Connection	\$2.50
For mass concrete, brick or other work using lime or cement, per sack of cement or barrel of lime.	\$.25
For settling backfill in pipe or sewer trenches, per 100 feet	\$2.00

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
