A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD WATER DISTRICT AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, The State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) is designed to prevent terrorism and prepare the Nation for threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security and resilience of the United States, and the greatest risks along the Nation's borders; and,
