ORDINANCE NO. 38 A ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 22 RELATING TO METER TEST DEPOSITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. PARAGRAPH No. 174 of Article 9, Ordinance No. 6 is amended to read as follows:

174. METER TEST DEPOSITS

All meters will be tested prior to installation and no meter will be installed which registers more than two per cent (2%) fast. If a customer desires to have the meter serving his premises tested, he shall first deposit Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for meters up to 3/4" in size. Should the meter register more than two percent (2%) fast, the deposit will be refunded, but should the meter register less than two per cent (2%) fast, the deposit will be retained by the Water District.

2. This ORDINANCE shall take effect May 10, 1978

ORDINANCE NO. 38 A ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 22 RELATING TO METER TEST DEPOSITS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IDYLLWILD COUNTY WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

1. PARAGRAPH No. 174 of Article 9, Ordinance No. 6 is amended to read as follows:

174. METER TEST DEPOSITS

All meters will be tested prior to installation and no meter will be installed which registers more than two per cent (2%) fast. If a customer desires to have the meter serving his premises tested, he shall first deposit Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for meters up to 3/4" in size. Should the meter register more than two percent (2%) fast, the deposit will be refunded, but should the meter register less than two per cent (2%) fast, the deposit will be retained by the Water District.
